

2010-2011 Holy Family Catholic School Uniform Dress Code and Student Appearance

All students in grades K-8 wear uniforms to school. Uniforms are not required for preschoolers. For the 2010-2011 school year, previous uniforms from St. Joseph School and St. Charles Borromeo School may not be worn.

Holy Family uniforms can be ordered through our website uniform company Corporate Casuals. All orders are placed directly with Corporate Casuals and are delivered to your home. Please be sure to leave enough time for shipping. All items must be ordered by August 13th to guarantee arrival for the first day of school. Some required items are not available through Corporate Casuals and may be purchased through a department store, catalog-company, or outside retailer (Land's End, Old Navy, etc.). We hope to have these items available on our website at a later time. All sizing information and prices are available through the uniform site. Please be aware that a portion of all uniform purchases through Corporate Casuals goes toward funding the athletic program and updating the school gymnasium. Corporate Casuals will donate a portion of our sales back to us for that use.

Daily Uniform

Boys K-4

- Navy uniform pants (purchase through an outside retailer). Cargo pants, knit pants, painter pants or corduroys are not acceptable uniform pants.
- White Holy Family Polo shirt- long or short sleeves (purchase through the uniform website).
- Holy Family Crewneck sweatshirt (optional) (purchase through website)
- Black or brown dress shoes
- Navy, Khaki, Black or White dress socks. Athletic socks are not acceptable as a part of the daily uniform.

Girls K-4

- Navy uniform pants (purchase through an outside retailer). Cargo pants, knit pants, painter pants or corduroys are not acceptable uniform pants.
- Navy skort/scooter. This cannot be any shorter than 2" above the knee. (purchase through an outside retailer)

- White Holy Family Polo shirt- long or short sleeves (purchase through uniform website).
- Holy Family Crewneck sweatshirt (optional) (purchase through website)
- Dark colored dress shoe (black, brown, or navy)
- Navy, Khaki, Black or White dress socks. Girls can also wear white knee high socks or crew socks that cover the ankle with a skort/scooter. Athletic socks are not acceptable as a part of the daily uniform.

Boys 5-8

- Navy uniform pants (purchase through an outside retailer). Cargo pants, knit pants, painter pants, or corduroys are not acceptable uniform pants.
- White Holy Family short sleeve polo shirt (purchase through the uniform website). These can only be worn August, September, and May. A tie does not have to be worn with the polo shirt, however the shirt must be tucked in at all times.
- Holy Family long sleeve button-up shirt (purchase through the uniform website).
- Navy blue necktie to be worn with the long sleeve button-up shirt (purchase through the school office or an outside retailer).
- Holy Family crewneck sweatshirt (optional) (purchase through uniform website).
- Black or brown dress shoes
- Navy, Khaki, Black or White dress socks. Athletic socks are not acceptable as a part of the daily uniform.

Girls 5-8

- Navy uniform pants (purchase through an outside retailer). Cargo pants, knit pants, painter pants or corduroys are not acceptable uniform pants.
- Navy skort/scooter. This cannot be any shorter than 2" above the knee. (purchase through an outside retailer).
- Holy Family ladies long sleeve button-up shirt (purchase through uniform website).
- Holy Family white girls short sleeve shirt (purchase through uniform website). These can only be worn August, September, and May.
- Crossover tie to be worn with the long sleeve button-up shirt (purchase through the school office).
- Holy Family Crewneck sweatshirt (optional) (purchase through website).
- Dark Colored Dress Shoes (Black, Brown, or Navy)
- Navy, Khaki, Black or White dress socks. Girls can also wear white knee high socks or crew socks that cover the ankle with the skort/scooter. Athletic socks are not acceptable as a part of the daily uniform.

Gym Uniform K-8

- Holy Family gym t-shirt (purchase through uniform website)
- Navy Blue mesh shorts (available on the uniform website)
- Navy Blue sweatpants (optional) (available through the uniform website)
- Athletic socks and gym shoes are required for gym class.
- Students may want to bring their HF sweatshirts on cooler days in the event gym class is held outdoors.

Student Appearance

- Students should always be well groomed, neat and clean.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Junior High students (grades 5-8) may wear their short sleeve HF polo shirts during the months of August, September and May. The other months the students must be in long sleeve dress shirts with a navy tie (both boys and girls).
- All students must wear sensible black, brown, or navy dress/school type shoes. No heels higher than 1".
- Gym shoes may not be worn to school, but must be changed into for gym class.
- Jewelry, makeup, nail polish, or acrylic nails may not be worn. If nail polish or makeup is worn to school, the student will be required to remove it.
- Girls with pierced ears may wear a small, non-dangling earring. NO PIERCING is allowed for boys. No piercing other than the earlobe for girls.
- Watches may be worn to school, but caution is recommended. Holy Family Catholic School is not responsible for lost items.
- Hair should be kept neat and clean at all times. No extreme hair styles (spiking, Mohawk, etc.) are allowed.
- No extreme headbands, hair ribbons, bandanas, or hair extenders should be worn.
- Boys' hair should be trimmed neatly above the collar line, 1/2 inch above the eyebrow, and 1/2 inch above the ear.

Out of Uniform Days

- Students may earn out of uniform passes to be used throughout the year.
- Out of Uniform passes may not be used on a mass day.
- Students may not wear extreme styles of clothing on out of uniform days.
- Girls may not wear spaghetti straps or any shirt that exposes their stomachs.
- All out of uniform shorts may not be any shorter than 1" above the knee.
- All jeans/pants that are worn on out of uniform days must be fitting at the waist and may not fall beneath the waist.
- Jeans/pants worn on out of uniform days may not have any rips, holes, or tears in them.
- No make-up may be worn on out of uniform days.

Spirit Wear Days

- The last Friday of every month is Spirit Wear Day. Any student who participates in our designated monthly service project can wear spirit wear with acceptable jeans and gym shoes.
- Spirit wear is considered to be: PE shirt and sweatpants, a PLAIN yellow or purple t-shirt without any logos or writing on it, spirit wear purchased through Corporate Casuals, our uniform website or the school office.

The principal's decision is final when making a determination on any questionable student appearance.
