There are three options for paying tuition. You may elect one payment to be paid on or before Book Day. If you elect this option, you will receive 3% off of your tuition. You may make the tuition payments in two installments with the first being on Book Day and the second on February 1, 2012. Payments may be paid monthly using direct withdrawal from your bank account, arranged through FACTS tuition management program. There will be a small enrollment fee charged by FACTS. Credit card payments will be accepted for tuition if prearranged through the business office. You will receive detailed paperwork regarding tuition payment options during the month of May from our business office.

Full-Day Pre-School Multi-Sibling Discount

Preschool is not a part of compulsory attendance in the State of Illinois. As a result, preschool is not mandatory in Illinois. Because of this fact, all preschools are required by the Diocese of Joliet to be self supporting and, therefore, do not receive any parish subsidy. The preschool tuition has been set to meet all of our budgetary needs to successfully run the preschool program at Holy Family. Because preschool must be self-sustaining, we are able to provide a 10% multi-sibling discount for full day preschool. We are pleased that we can offer this to our preschool families and we hope that you will find it helpful.

2 Children = \$ 7,255 (1 child in K-8 and 1 child in full-day PS)
3 Children = \$ 9,353 (@ children in K-8 and 1 child in full-day PS)
2 Children in full-day PS = \$ 8,037
